

Selection Committee At a Glance

Before Referral

Give teachers the GT Referral Checklist form to complete if they want to refer a student to GT. Remind them not to speak to parents until the committee makes the decision for further testing.

Selection Committee meets to determine if student is a strong referral. If the decision is

yes

Obtain Parent Permission.
Have parents & teachers complete observations.
Send GT referral checklist, parent permission and observations to the appropriate clerk in the GT office.

no

Inform teacher of committee's decision.



There is a two week window once you receive the completed referrals to meet and decide if the child will be placed into the GT program. We will notify parents of the decision once the form is returned to the GT office.

After Testing

After Terry and Kim complete all of the required assessments, they will send the results to you. You will need to reconvene the Selection Committee and review the scores.

A student needs to score 27 or more points on the profile sheet to be placed into the gifted program.

The Selection Committee does have the opportunity to submit extra evidence for students scoring between 24 - 27.

No score below 24 will be placed into the GT program.
